HOW DO I REGISTER?

1—Log on to www.uintacounty.com or, contact Pam or Kim for a paper application.

2—On the website, look for the word volunteers, click on it and when the next page opens, click on Additional info...

3—To register only in Uinta County, click on "application" or to register on the WAVE website for possible statewide assignment, select the word "click".

4— If you would prefer to speak to someone in person about volunteering, please call Pam or Kim at the numbers on this brochure or on the website.

5—Fill out the required information, then call Pam or Kim for final instructions.

6— If there is a need for volunteers, you will receive a call asking if you can help us with more information about time and a place to meet.

Remember, this system is VOLUNTARY.

Registering means you are willing to volunteer, but it does not commit you.
