

### **Draft Internal Policy for Implementation of Chapter 8 Rules Section 21 (d) and (e)**

Until a WLSB Board Order or a change to this section of the rule is made, Animal Health Staff will permit for importation without negative Brucellosis and Pseudorabies tests any swine entering from states that are Brucellosis Free and Pseudorabies Stage IV or higher and the state veterinarian has verified that swine from the area where the swine originate are of negligible risk of exposure to feral swine and infection with swine Brucellosis and/or Pseudorabies virus.

The accredited veterinarian issuing a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection shall write the statement, "I have examined the swine represented on this CVI at their premises of origin and attest that there is no risk of exposure to feral swine."

The accredited veterinarian acquiring the import permit shall attest to the above statement.

And,

There shall be no required test for swine moving directly to a Wyoming approved slaughter establishment to be killed within three days of arrival.
